

ERYAÑIZ 'S STORY -



Eryañiz is a Puerto Rican teen enrolled in Hope Academy for Kids, a FAKH agency partner. She is fluent in both English and Spanish and acted as a translator while distributing food to neighbors in need over the summer - including her own family.

For many families like Eryañiz's, higher grocery bills - to replace breakfast and

lunch that students would normally receive at school - make already stretched budgets tighter, and can leave many without resources to purchase back to school items such as clothes. notebooks and more.



As a volunteer, Eryañiz helps ensure that neighbors in her community are able to get the resources they need, without language being a barrier.


